New Business

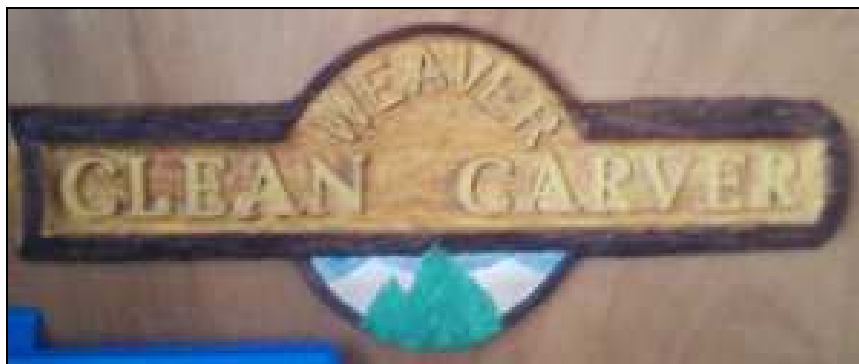
- Tom Nelson's carving tools were for sale at the meeting. The following is a note of thanks from his wife Helen.
